- Hours: 3 ½ hr. sessions, am and pm classes operating Monday – Thursday, September through May. Children must be 3 by Dec. 1st of the current school year. Children accepted ages 3 to 5 for those that qualify. Snack and lunch are served for the am session; lunch and snack for pm session.
- Transportation is available based on need.
- Comprehensive, licensed child care arrangements are available. DHS assistance and tuition scholarships are available to those who qualify.
